## Changes to the Collective Agreement

 Modified Workload Agreement- Only $20 \%$ of faculty can be on a modified workload agreement
- 2/3 of faculty in a program must agree to the modified workload
- A modified workload agreement must last the term of the Collective Agreement
- Must be told through a faculty meeting


## Changes to the Collective Agreement

 Modified Workload Agreement - Con't- Union must agree to the modified agreement within 5 days
- Overtime agreements (hours /year, days taught, weeks taught) can be exceeded in the modified workload but must remain below the maxima when averaged over the term of the Collective Agreement.
- The supervisor must show you the plans for all the years that the modified agreement is in place

- Vacations can now be taken without having to use the full 2 months, at your request


## Changes to the Collective Agreement

Short Term Disability

- The College can now require an independent medical exam, but would be required to pay for the independent exam or documentation

Vision Care

- \$400/2 years over 18 years old
- \$400/year under 18 years old

Dental Plan

- Increased to \$2500 lyear
